

WHAT IS THE UHS SUBSCRIPTION PROGRAM?

It is designed to provide a bridge for students who skip a semester, particularly for students who are not attending summer school at UT. It also applies to recently graduated students who may have a break between graduation and employment or graduate school, non-registered University scholars, post-doctoral fellows, students enrolled in the English as a Second Language (ESL) program, and non-matriculated admits (one month prior to the beginning of their first semester).

The program allows subscribers to use University Health Services like registered students do. The subscription fee, which is equal to the portion of tuition designated for medical services, entitles you to use our Nurse Advice Line or schedule an appointment to see the healthcare provider of your choice with no additional office visit fee.

For currently-registered students, there is no "office visit" charge for an appointment except for:

- physical exams
- annual women's health exams
- initial travel health appointments
- Physical Therapy appointments
- visits to our Urgent Care clinic on weekends and holidays

Charges also apply for all supplies and procedures used to diagnose and treat illnesses and injuries. These include but are not limited to:

- lab tests
- x-rays
- medications
- immunizations

If you cannot pay at the time of service, UHS will post your charges to *What I Owe*. Stop by the UHS Cashier/Insurance office at SSB 2.106 or call (512) 475-8232 to find out:

- your balance due and options for payment
- whether we can bill your health insurance
- how to request reimbursement from your health insurance
- how to get health insurance if you don't have it
- answers to any questions about charges incurred at UHS

You must pay for purchases in the Pharmacy at the time of sale. The Pharmacy accepts most major prescription drug insurance plans.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO SUBSCRIBE TO UHS?

Any student who was registered for and completed the *previous* semester may subscribe for one additional semester. University scholars who are not officially registered in classes and post-doctoral fellows may also subscribe. To do so, these scholars must present specific documentation from the University program with which they are affiliated. Additionally students enrolled in the English as a Second Language (ESL) program, and non-matriculated admits (one month prior to the beginning of their first semester).

CAN I USE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SERVICES WITHOUT SUBSCRIBING?

If you completed the previous semester, you may see a physician, nurse practitioner, physician assistant, or integrated health counselor for a \$60 office visit fee without subscribing. The fee will apply for each visit with a healthcare provider. If you see a nurse, physical therapist, or dietitian, the office visit fee is \$30 per visit. By subscribing, you can avoid these office visit charges. (Charges still apply for procedures, medications, and supplies used to diagnose or treat illness or injury.)

Non-registered scholars must have the Student Health Insurance Plan OR UT Select and must pay the \$70 subscription fee to access routine UHS services. In certain emergencies, non-enrolled scholars may be seen in Urgent Care to be stabilized before being transferred to an off-campus healthcare facility. In such cases, a \$60 office visit fee is assessed in addition to other charges that may be incurred.

WHEN CAN I SUBSCRIBE?

If you are eligible, you may subscribe at any point during the semester. You must submit your subscription application **before** you access our services for your visit to be covered under the subscription program. If your clinic visit occurs when the Cashier/Insurance office is closed you may subscribe the following business day. *Previously-incurred office visit charges may not be applied to the subscription fee.*
